MONITORED ACCESS UPDATE

The monitored access security system is now up and running. 90% of PKVA residents have obtained access cards and as at 7 September 2012, 1289 cards had been activated.

The PKVA Committee would like to thank all those residents who have made the change possible and also to all the Representatives who gave of their time to assist with the implementation. Your efforts are much appreciated!

In order for this access system to operate effectively, the security guards need to carry out their duties responsibly and residents need to manage their access cards conscientiously.

All PKVA residents who have access cards are reminded that:

- Vehicle access cards are not transferable. If you move out of the area please notify your Representative or email Sue du Plessis of the PKVA Committee on sue.duplessis2@gmail.com so that the card/s can be cancelled
- In the event of your domestic worker leaving your employ, please advise your Representative or Sue du Plessis. Should you wish to transfer the use of the pedestrian card to a new employee, please give your Representative/Sue the name of the new employee so that the system can be updated
- All lost or stolen cards should immediately be reported to your representative or to Sue du Plessis so that the cards can be cancelled
